Communication Intern

Interns will create communication strategies for DC AAP's priorities. They will work closely with DC AAP staff to strengthen priority projects. Activities will include but not limited to:

- Gather news stories, conduct interviews and writing stories for monthly member newsletter.
- Assist in virtual event planning.
- Other communication activities based on interest and skill set.
- Duties as assigned.

Program Intern

Interns will work on immunization and lead projects in the District of Columbia. They will work closely with the DC AAP staff. Activities will include but not limited to:

- Provide assistance in research to DC AAP committees on priority programs
- Assist in program development.
- Assist DC AAP staff on program execution.
- Provide support on virtual meetings and gatherings.
- Duties as assigned.
